



Notice of Vote by Mail Application Renewal

Dear Voter,

Earlier this year you requested that we mail you a ballot for all elections you are eligible to participate in during 2020.

If you want to continue to receive mail ballots in 2021, you must complete a new application. You can apply online at vote.elections.virginia.gov or return the enclosed application to the Arlington County Elections Office. You can return the application via mail, fax, scanned email attachment, or in person at the Office or mail slot located at 2100 Clarendon Blvd (information provided at top of letter). Only **one** submission of either method is required.

If you want to vote by mail, the following information will help ensure the timely processing of your application.

- **Section 2:** If you are applying for all elections in 2021, you can leave the date of the election blank.
- **Section 3:** To receive ballots for all elections in 2021, **check yes**. To receive ballots for primary elections, you must indicate your party preference in Section 3. Only one party may be selected. If a party preference is not listed a primary ballot will not be sent.
- **Section 4:** Provide your residence address.
- **Section 5:** If you need your ballot sent to an address other than your residence, please provide the mailing address in Section 5. The mailing address provided will be used for **all** elections held in 2021.
- **Section 7a:** If you have recently moved or changed names you can update your registration by completing Section 7a.

- **Section 7d:** If you require assistance with voting your ballot, complete Section 7d.
- **Section 8:** Sign and date the application.

If you do not want to vote by mail in 2021, no action is needed. Do not return the enclosed application. You can vote in person early or on election day or request a mail ballot at a later date.

Upcoming Elections in 2021

November 2, 2021 General Election for the offices of

- Governor
- Lieutenant Governor
- Attorney General
- Virginia House of Delegates
- County Board (1 seat)
- School Board (1 seat)

A Primary Election, if called for by the political parties, will be held at a date to be determined (TBD).

Ballots will be mailed 45 days prior to an Election. An application for a mail ballot can be submitted anytime up to 11 days prior to an Election.
